This is a general management program which develops balanced leaders who take on full P&L and balance sheet responsibility for significant parts of our business.

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Recruitment Process

The recruitment process may vary slightly from state to state, but typically involves the following:

Online Application

This is a chance to share your background, skills, education and work history and anything else that demonstrates your suitability for the Management Development Program. You should include a cover letter and your resume.

Phone/Video Interview

Potential graduates will be contacted via phone or video to clarify any questions either party has and introduce the candidate to the business.

Psychometric Testing

Applicants who progress to this stage will be required to complete a series of assessments – an occupational personality questionnaire as well as inductive, numerical, verbal reasoning and mechanical tests. The assessments are completed online.

Interview

The interview is a chance for us to find out a bit more about you and what makes you a good fit for Hanson. It's also a great chance for you to ask any questions you may have about us or the MDP.

Offer

Successful candidates will be offered a position on the MDP. We will negotiate a start date with you at this time.

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the eligibility requirements for the Management Development Program?

You are eligible to apply for the MDP if you:

- Are an Australian citizen
- Have completed a university degree within the last two years, or are completing your final year of study
- Are available to participate in all components of the selection process
- Are willing to undertake work in remote and regional areas

What type of degrees are you looking for?

The MDP is open to graduate from all degree areas.

Do I need previous work experience to apply?

Previous work experience is desirable but not a requirement of the program.

When do applications open/close?

Applications typically open in February and September and close a month after. Specific dates will be advised closer to the application opening date.

What do I need to do after submitting my application?

Make sure you monitor your email inbox regularly for any updates about the progress of your application. We will be in touch as soon as possible.

Where will I be working?

Hanson has sites located across metropolitan and regional areas. You may be asked to rotate to a number of these throughout your program.

How long does the Program run for?

The MDP is designed as a two year program, however some graduates may progress from the program earlier depending on positions available and the needs of the business.

What happens after the Program finishes?

As you are nearing the end of the MDP you will be encouraged to look out and apply for any position.
